Meet Procedures

All meet information will be posted on the www.ohsaa.org and www.cdab.org web sites.

All coaches are responsible for reading and understanding the tournament information as presented on the web sites and discussed at the mandatory rules interpretation meetings.

All swimming competition shall follow the 2017-18 National Federation Swimming and Diving Rule Book. Read and understand the rules for championship competition.

Coaches should make sure that all swimmers and divers are aware of the meet procedures.

1. There will NOT be a "bullpen". It is each swimmer's responsibility to be on the block for his/her event when the event is ready to go.
2. **IF A SWIMMER MISSES AN EVENT, THE SWIMMER IS AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIED FROM THAT EVENT AND ALSO FROM FURTHER COMPETITION. HE/SHE WILL NOT BE PLACED IN ANOTHER HEAT.**
3. No team or individual will be allowed to warm-up or compete in the boys' or girls' swimming or diving competition unless the coach or representative authorized by the team's Board of Education is present at all times during the meet. Teams or individuals unaccompanied by such representatives will be disqualified from all competition.
4. Starting blocks are equipped with kick plates and backstroke ledges. Kick plates use is permitted; however, backstroke ledges are NOT permitted to be used during high school competition.
5. All swimmers, including members of relay teams, must stay behind the timers before and after they swim.
6. The finish of each heat will be recorded electronically if the swimmer hits the touch pad as hard as possible. The backup system will be two semi-automatic push buttons and two manual stopwatches. NOTE: The electronic times that are displayed on the scoreboard will NOT be the official times.
7. Scoring will be as follows:

Relays	40, 34, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2
Individuals	20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2,
8. Continuous swimming warm-up/cool-down space will be available in the adjacent half of the Competition Pool. Swimming equipment is not permitted in the south end of the pool (nearest the Dive Well). Equipment may be used in the north end of the Competition Pool only. Assigned sprint lanes will be posted.
9. **SAFETY:** Swimming under the bulkhead and pushing up from the bottom of the pool near the bulkhead is NOT PERMITTED. The lane in the warm-up facility immediately next to the bulkhead is not open for use.

Deck Access

Coaches and competing swimmers will be permitted into the competition area with a participant pass.

Passes for coaches/swimmers may be picked up by the head coach at the Facility main entrance.

Please instruct all team members that they will not be permitted into the competition area until a designated coach distributes the contestant passes.

Each day is defined as a separate session and there is an admission fee for all individuals that are not competing in a specific swim session.

Each team will receive passes from the coach for those team members **actually competing in the meet**.

Team members that are not competing (alternates), stats, cheerleaders, etc. must pay the spectator's \$7.00 fee per session and remain in the spectator's seating area.

Spectator Seating Area

Only paid ticket holders are permitted in the spectator area.

No competing swimmers, divers or coaches will be permitted in the spectator area during warm-ups or competition.

Team Seating

Teams will be seated on the pool deck. At this time there are only four sets of bleachers in the venue so unlike last year when you could reserve bleachers for your team, this opportunity is not available.

Coaches should encourage swimmers to only bring needed items to the meet.

NOTE: Pillows, blankets, sleeping bags, coolers, noisemakers, shakers, helium balloons, camping chairs are NOT permitted in the aquatic venue. Leave all such items in the bus or the car.

Coaches should plan to have their teams arrive early. The deck opens at 2:00 p.m Friday and 1:00p.m Saturday.

Locker Rooms

Changing rooms, showers, and restrooms are available for all contestants in the Facility.

Lockers that belong to the Ohio University Recreational Sports Members have locks on them – event participants are permitted to use lockers that are open and may use their own lock to secure their belongings.

Swimmers may take their belongings to the pool deck or secure them in a locker. Neither The Ohio University, nor the meet administration, will be responsible for personal valuables.

District Meet Results

District Meet results will be posted on www.swimmeet.com and www.ohsaa.org and www.cdab.org as soon as all of the times have been verified and as soon as possible on Sunday, February 18, 2018.

If you believe there is an error, a coach should contact Frank Croft ASAP at frankcroft6889@gmail.com. Frank Croft will only discuss errors, deletions, questions, etc. with the team's designated coach.

The State Meet Qualifiers will be posted on the www.ohsaa.org and www.cdab.org web sites as soon as possible on Sunday, February 18, 2018. **These are the only official meet qualifier web sites.**

All edive results from each District Diving tournament will be automatically sent to John Mihevic at mihevijp@miamioh.edu. If any of the coaches would like to make changes to the sheet that they had at Districts they can do so by emailing John at mihevijp@miamioh.edu or make the changes at the state tournament.

Pool Information

Ohio University's competitive aquatic facility consists of two large bodies of water for competition and warm-up/cool-down..

The Ohio University Natatorium Competition Pool is a 10 lane, 50-meter indoor pool that will be divided into two 10-lane 25-yard competition pools for this meet.

The competition pool course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

The water depth is greater than 7 ft. from the starting blocks at both ends of the pool.
We will be using 10 lanes for all sessions.

Facility Information

Deck Access

Deck access is restricted to competing athletes, registered coaches, officials and meet workers. Parents and spectators will be allowed on the deck only to perform a service or function at the request of meet management.

Banners

One professionally made banner per team may be displayed in the Aquatic Pavilion. There are wire to which your banner may be attached. Do not tape banners to the walls.

Concession/Food

The concession stand at the Ohio University facility will be available throughout the competition.

Deck Changing

Deck changing is not permitted.

Equipment

Swimming equipment (fins, paddles, etc.) is not permitted in the competition pool when timing equipment is in place. Equipment may be used in the adjacent warm-up/cool-down pool.

First Aid / Training Needs

Lifeguards are trained to handle water rescues and first aid on deck. Please report all first aid issues to the Aquatic Staff.

No athletic trainers will be provided by the facility or the event. Training ice is available in the freezer located outside of the wet classroom.

Flash Photography

Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race.

Handicap Access

Accommodations for persons with disabilities may be arranged with five days advance notice. Email Frank Croft at frankcroft6889@gmail.com to request accommodations.

Lost & Found

Lost and Found for the event is kept at the head swimming table/announcer's area. Immediately following the meet

Public Health

If you are ill, please stay home. Please wash your hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds after changing clothes, using the restrooms and before and after eating.

Prohibited Items

The following items are not permitted in the facility: glass, lawn or camping chairs, coolers and outside food, tobacco, alcohol, illegal substances, helium balloons or noise makers.

Smoke and Tobacco Free Campus

The Ohio State University is a smoke free and tobacco free campus.

Spectator Information

The ticket box office and the doors to the seating area will be open at 11:00 a.m.

Spectator admission price to the District Swimming and Diving competitions will be \$7.00 per person for each session. Tickets will be sold at the ticket office. Alternates, cheerleaders, timers, etc. must pay the admission price.

Heat Sheets (programs) will be sold inside the main entrance to the Aquatic Pavilion and will be available at a cost of \$5.00.

Only cash will be accepted. To expedite your entry, please be prepared to pay with exact change.

These prices have been determined by the Central District Athletic Board

Only those individuals that have purchased a spectator's ticket will be permitted to sit in the spectator area. No competing swimmers or coaches will be permitted in the spectator area during competition or warm-ups. Only swimmers and coaches with credentials will be permitted on the pool deck.

There is no "Reserved Seating". Spectators may NOT in any way attempt to "save" seats for spectators. Coolers, large bags, hand-held banners, signs, noisemakers, balloons, umbrellas and chairs that infringe on walkways are prohibited. Items obstructing the view of others or items taking more space than a seat are prohibited. The use of videotaping equipment must adhere to the OHSAA policy. **FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY IS PROHIBITED AT THE START OF EACH RACE. Individuals not complying with these rules will be removed from the seating area and will not be reimbursed their ticket cost.**

Some parents like to assist as lane timers rather than sitting in the stands. 22 lane timers are needed. Parents serving as lane timers be provided with a wristband, lane assignment, and a reporting time – they will not be required to pay for admission. To volunteer, simply check in with the staff selling heat sheets.

Paper results will NOT be posted for spectators. Unofficial meet results will be available on Meet Mobile.

District Diving Tournament: Instructions for Entries

If your school uses edive, please send a text (.TXT) file of your entries to Melanie Ryan at melryan1029@yahoo.com. Please do not send database files, as the tournament site is unable to process those types of files.

If your school does not use edive, or you are unable to send a text file, there are two options:

When completing the form the "Meet Hosts Email" is melryan1029@yahoo.com, the "Meet Name" is District Tournament, and the "Event Name" is gender and division of your divers (example: Girls Division 1). Please be sure to follow-up with Melanie to make sure the information was received.

2. You can send an email directly to Melanie (melryan1029@yahoo.com) with your diver entry information; which includes diver's name, school, and diver numbers. Each piece of information should be separated with a comma, make sure you are accurate with your entries, and that the voluntary dives are noted with a "V" following the diver number.
